



From monoculture to diversity: the first step

- First Luxembourg was a poor country and almost based on agriculture
- Then iron and steel created the prosperity of Luxembourg
- With the decline of the iron and steel industry around 1970, Luxembourg started to build up another sector: banking and finance, a first step to diversify it's economy
- The growth in the financial sector has more than compensated the decline of iron and steel

- Grand Duchy of Luxemburg, a unitary parlamentary constitutional monarchy
- Population: 580.000 (2x Porto)
 - 46% foreign population (7% from Portugal)
- Area: 2.586 KM²
 - $D = 357.000 \text{ KM}^2 / P = 92.000 \text{ KM}^2$
- 150.000 commuters (F / Be / G)
- 3 official languages (Lux / F / G)
- GDP: 104.000 USD
 - F/D = 44-45.000 USD / P = 22.000 USD




† The Second step: the University


