## Voltage

Electricity in through Austria is supplied a 230 Volts 50 Hz system. Austria uses the Europlug (CEE 7/16), which is used in most other European countries. Visitors from the following European countries will have to use an adapter: Italy, United Kingdom, Ireland, Cyprus, Malta, Switzerland, Liechtenstein, Denmark. Visitors from outside Europe will also need an adapter to use their electrical appliances in Austria.

### Visa requirement

EU citizens do not need a visa and can travel into Austria on either a passport or an ID card. Non-EU citizens are advised to check the requirements on the <u>government website</u>.
