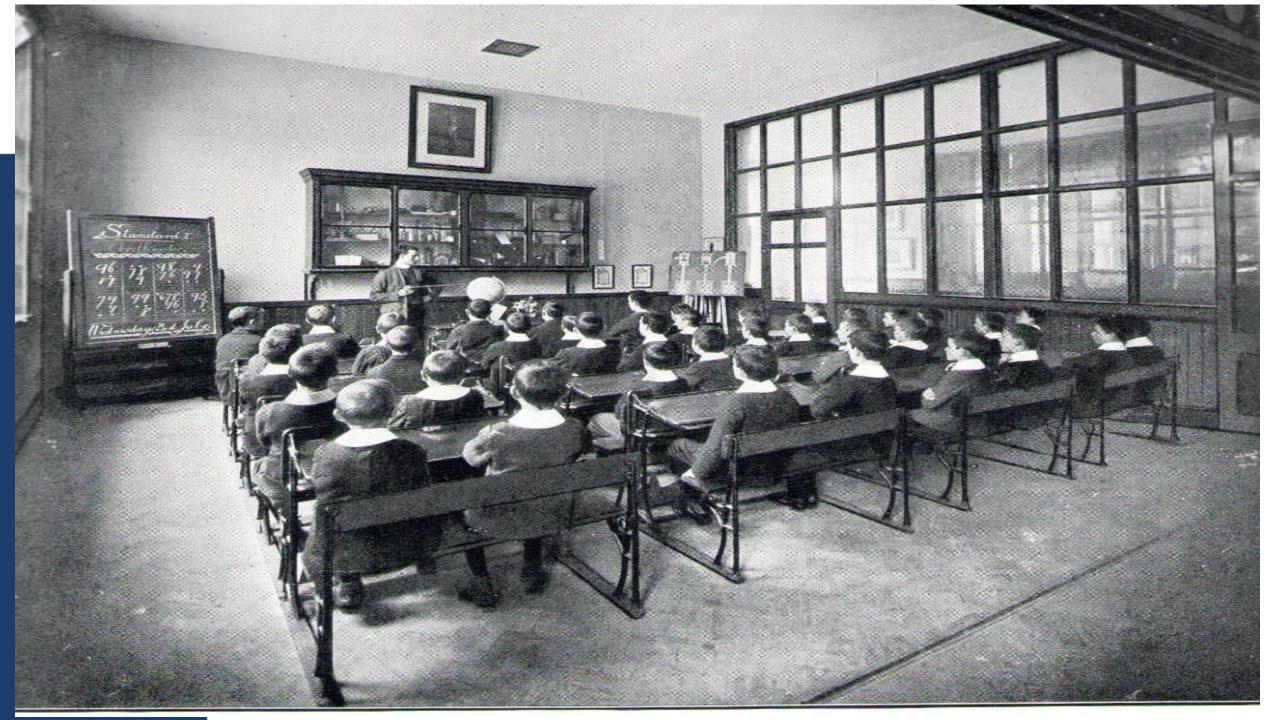

Ireland has slipped down the OECD education rankings in literacy and maths, in a move which could damage the strong international standing of the Irish educational system.





On reading levels, Ireland has slipped from 5th place in 2000 to 17th place, the sharpest decline among 39 countries surveyed.

In maths, Ireland has fallen from 16th to 26th place, the second steepest decline among participating countries. Ireland is now ranked as below average in maths.

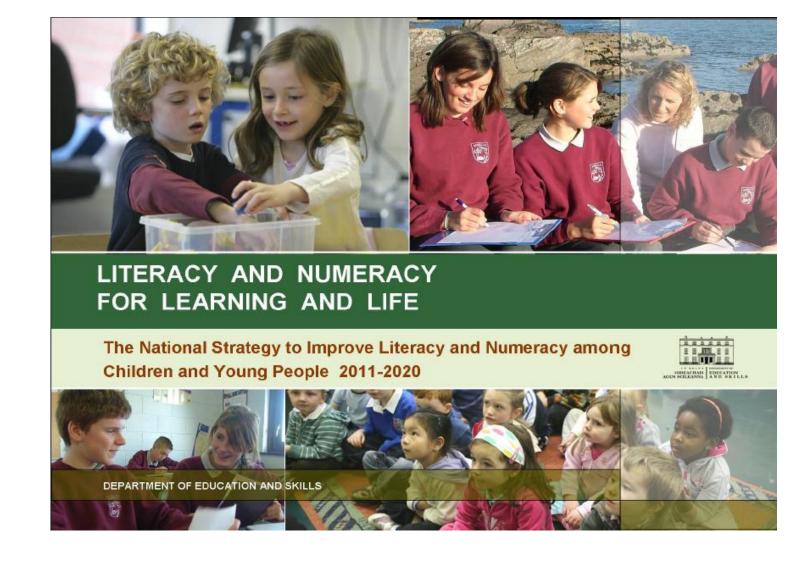

"We believe that in order to advance further in its national teacher education system, Ireland needs to invest more in the continuous improvement of the quality of teaching, the role of research in teacher education, and international cooperation in all of its teacher education institutions.



In each of these areas of development, size is a significant factor. Institutions with limited resources – both human and financial – more often than not find breakthroughs in transformation difficult. Therefore, having larger professional communities with more diverse knowledge and skills often unlocks creativity and innovation for further improvement".

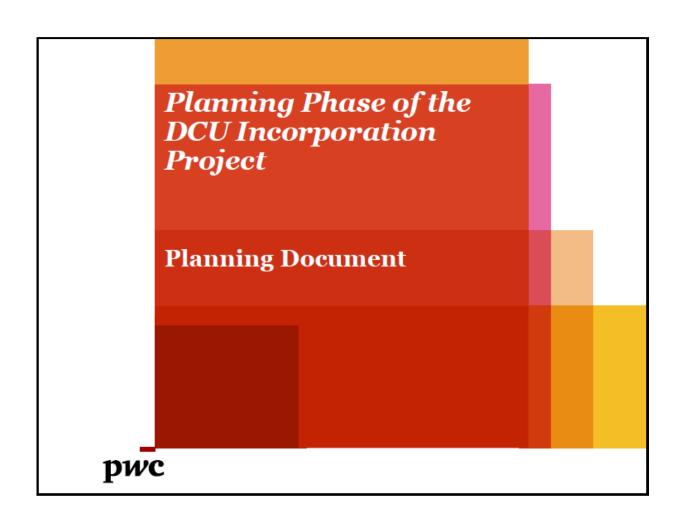

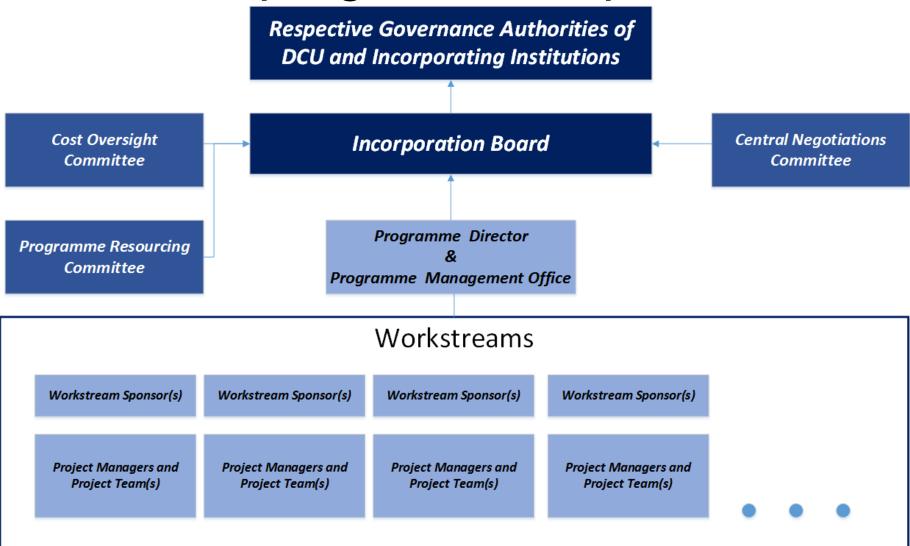


2013: Initial phase of planning complete

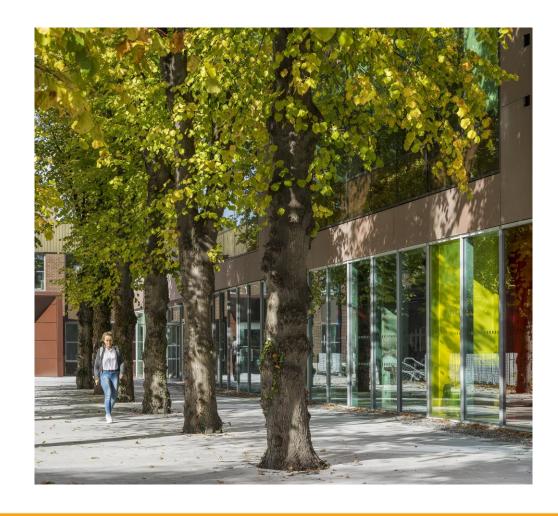




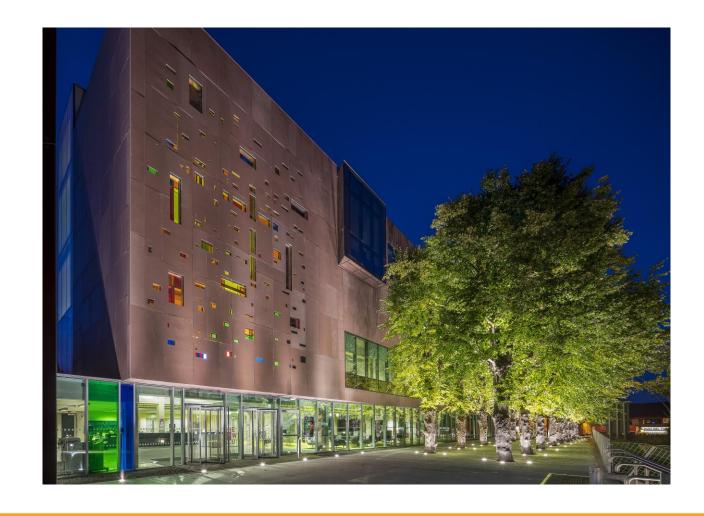

Institutional Mergers - Some Dos and Don'ts



Do....

- Understand and address culture the success of the merger will depend on how well you do this
- Have a clear and ambitious vision and collective buy-in by leadership of all incorporating institutions
- -Communicate this vision and keep returning to it
- Develop a plan, set early deliverables and keep the plan under review
- Celebrate the milestones and achievements along the way.



Don't....

- Neglect communications and use a variety of channels
- Ignore the change management listen to the concerns of staff and students and keep Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs in mind
- Allow silos to be built up or reinforced keep challenging silo mentality
- Delay set timelines and stick to them
- Under-estimate the resources required to deliver the project it cannot be done on a part time basis.
