

Call for Contributions for the EUA Workshops on Research Assessment in the Transition to Open Science

EUA has opened a call for contributions to a series of workshops on research assessment in the transition to Open Science. The 2019 workshop will focus on “[Research Assessment for Researchers’ Recruitment and Career Progression](#)”. The one-day event will take place on 14 May 2019 in the University Foundation in Brussels, Belgium.

Contributions should be related to research assessment reform, which broadly refers to the search for more accurate, transparent and responsible approaches to research evaluation. EUA is particularly interested in new and innovative research assessment practices for the purposes of:

- Recruitment and career progression of individual researchers
- Evaluating the performance of research units
- Allocating research funding within the institution

To submit a contribution, please complete the [online proposal form](#). The deadline to submit is **Friday 1 March 2019**. We will notify you about the outcome of your submission before 22 March.

To help you prepare your contribution, please note that the online proposal form will ask you to provide the following information:

- Details of one presenter
- Details of an additional contact person and up to three co-authors (optional)
- Choose to which above-mentioned research assessment purpose the contribution relates most
- Contribution title
- Contribution summary (max 50 words)
- If applicable, how the contribution fosters Open Science and Open Access (max 100 words)
- Contribution (max 800 words)
