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

What You Know vs How much you know about it





The new role of the 'supervisor' or 'advisor'

- Subject knowledge
- Research methods knowledge **plus:**
 - Learning Needs Analyses
 - Guide towards development opportunities
 - Provide development opportunities



Tools to help the student and supervisor

- Learning/Training Needs Analyses to identify skills for development
- E-Portfolio/Diploma supplement to record development activities and encourage early awareness of need to acquire skills, experience and competences and reflect on these.



Higher Education Achievement Records (HEAR) in UK

- The Higher Education Achievement Report (HEAR) is designed to encourage a more sophisticated approach to recording student achievement, which acknowledges fully the range of opportunities that higher education institutions in the UK offer to their students.



- HEAR launched in 2008 (with 18 institutions). Initially UG, then PGT. Currently, 90 universities and colleges are implementing or planning to implement the HEAR. This includes 32 institutions who have already issued 427,000 HEARs to students – and this number is increasing annually.
- Higher Education Academy (HEA) provides the national support for implementation and maintenance of the HEAR



The Problem

E.g. publications, conferences, industrial placements, what they have done?




- How do you capture the details of individuals' achievements

The UK Draft Template

- Originated in Swansea University, Wales
 - Informed by students' views
 - Input from the academics
 - Endorsement from Academic Committees
- National Webinars (UK universities and national organisations)
- Swansea University and King's College London tasked with:
 - Promoting national debate
 - Engaging with European Universities
 - Addressing software challenges

The Template (Circulated)

- Based on Diploma Supplement template – but with refinement
- Electronic version based on Swansea University's E.C. – endorsed e-Diploma Supplement
- Adapted for Research Students
- Produced by Gradintel Software System from a test database

Recording Achievements and details of research


1. Drawn from Students Record System – check what you record on your systems
2. Drawn from a student/supervisor “record of achievement” e-document
3. Report generated by software and issued by the University centrally

Your university allows these achievements to be self-recorded by their students.




The Gradintel Software
