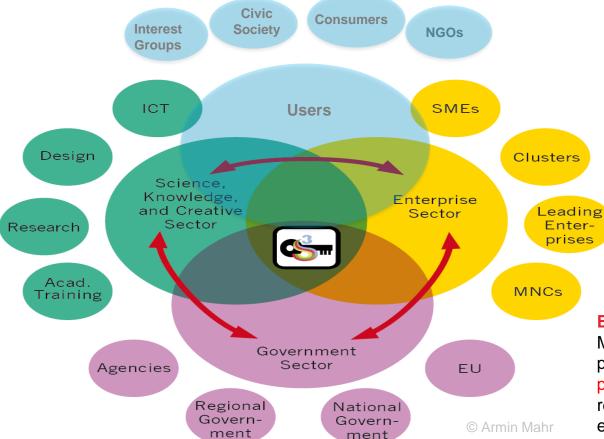

Smart specialisation: Mobilising partners





Entrepreneurial discovery:

Mobilising the expertise of all partners helps to set the right public investment priorities for regional innovation ecosystems.

- Significance: Entrepreneurial drivers of their region, market or branch (innovators, agents of structural change)
- Sustainability in management
- Responsibility: Inclusion of societal and regional / environmental targets in the entrepreneurial portfolio

In some EU countries, there are schemes that award companies with the Lead Company seal (DE, AT: ,Leitunternehmen' / 'Leitbetrieb').

Lead Institutions



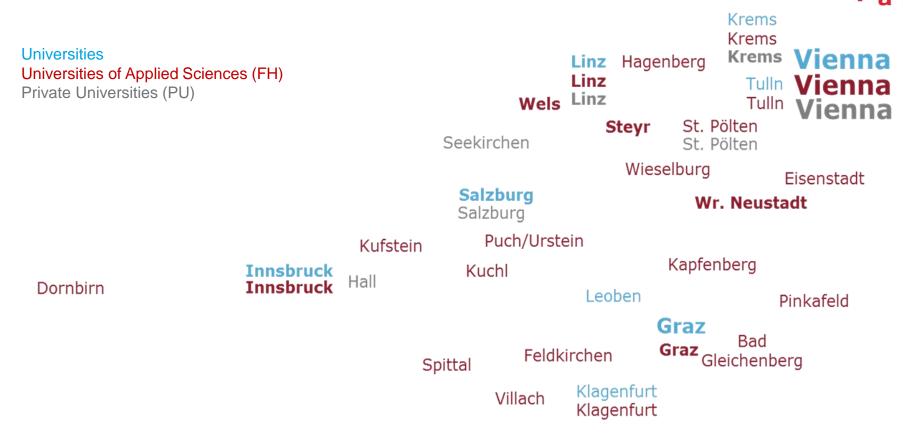
- Significance: Entrepreneurial drivers of their region, pushing knowledge production and frontiers, lighthouses of the innovation eco-system and of structural change
- Sustainability: HEI and PRI are established to last, and to produce public goods.
- Responsibility: Research, education and engagement as defined and accepted missions

Universities / knowledge institutions are **Lead Institutions** by nature/law. Role acceptance and empowerment are key.

In a **Location Concept** ('Standortkonzept') universities highlight their position within a network of strategic partners in academia, industry and business in a self-chosen radius of close collaboration.

"A Location Concept is a university's bridge from local engagement to global competitiveness."

Presenting a clustered innovation ecosystem or a critical mass of excellence rather than a single institution should support attracting international co-operations and investments.

- Universities Act, new university funding system: legal
- Performance agreements: negotiated planning & dialogue
- Development plans: central institutional strategy document
- Internationalisation strategy, location concept: institutional
- National Development Plan for Public Universities (2019-25): national template
- Joint planning documents for buildings, infrastructure etc.

To date, the Lead Institutions Initiative has used negotiated governance instruments (,strategic encouragement') rather than financial incentives/restrictions.

Austrian National Development Plan for Public Universities 2019-24

Objective 6d: Align knowledge locations with an international profile

Location matters. Universities are important partners in making Austria an internationally competitive place to create knowledge and innovation. Universities also draw crucial momentum for their own priority setting from local partnerships; and research, teaching and universities' local engagement also always have an impact in the specific urban and regional ecosystems context (European concept of smart specialisation).

Austrian National Development Plan for Public Universities 2019-24 – Objective 6d



Enshrining that objective in the development plans of the 22 public universities should help to

- position universities as lead institutions that, together with industry and society, shape the development of locations and regional ecosystems for innovation (e.g. through helping to generate findings and innovations),
- position universities as international partners with a strong local network,
- effect a change in perspective from a purely institutional viewpoint towards the development of knowledge locations with internationally recognised profiles,
- justify public investments through prior place-based co-ordination and alignment in academic research, teaching, management and services.

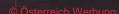
