- 4. A more social Europe (the European Pillar of Social Rights)
- 5. A Europe closer to citizens (sustainable development of urban, rural and coastal areas and local initiatives)



Other Smart Growth related EU Programmes

- **Horizon Europe** focus on <u>European research and innovation excellence</u>, the generation and exploitation of new knowledge and disruptive, market-creating innovations (€100 bn)
- **InvestEU**: market-based instruments, for strategic investments (€38bn (incl. €23 for R&I and SMEs) mobilising €650bn (incl. €415 for R&I, digitisation and SMEs)
- **Digital Europe**: <u>digital transformation</u> via AI, cyber-security, high performance computing, advanced digital skills, interoperability, deployment of digital solutions (€9.2 bn)
- **ESF+**: <u>inclusion, education and skills</u> to adapt to the current and future needs of the economy, health, labour mobility and social innovation (€100 bn)
- **Erasmus+**: <u>learning mobility of individuals</u> and cooperation, for education and training, creativity and innovation at the level of organisations (€30bn)
- **Reform Support Programme**: institutional reform and efficient and service-oriented functioning of public administration and e-government (€25 bn)
- LIFE programme: demonstrating techniques and best practice in Circular Economy, quality of life, climate mitigation and adaptation; and Clean Energy Transition (€5.4bn)
- **Creative Europe**: <u>creative and audiovisual industry</u>, promote cultural diversity and heritage, support culture-based creativity in education and innovation (€1.8 bn)
- Single Market Programme <u>business environment, entrepreneurship, support</u> the modernisation of industry, <u>SME access to markets and finance</u>, (€6 bn)
- Space Programme (Copernicus, Galileo, EGNOS) (€16 bn)
- Defence Fund: <u>EU defence industry</u> (€13bn, incl. €4.1 from Horizone rope) European
