## Importance of Quality Assurance (QA) of Assessments

- Higher Education Institutions
  - Assessments are important for students and their study progress
  - Quality Assurance of assessments is essential for the QA system
- European Standard and Guidelines for QA in Higher Education 2015:
  - 1.3 “Student-centred learning, teaching and assessment”
- Quality assurance agencies:
  - Swiss agency AAQ quality standard focusing on QA of assessment

## Austrian Public Universities & Swiss Agency AAQ

- Six cross-border quality audits 2014-2018
- Five certificates granted conditionally:
  - QA of assessments must be improved
- 2 yrs to develop process & fulfill condition
