## The University of Würzburg – Facts and Figures

- founded **1402**
- **28.193** students
  - 16.176 female
  - 2.510 international students (9%)
  - 4.975 first year students
  - 5.813 Teacher's education
  - 3.869 degrees
- **4.268** members of staff – including **437** professors
- **14** Nobel Laureates, e. g. Wilhelm Conrad **Röntgen**
- budget (2016): **€ 454 million**
- third-party funds (2016): **€ 101 million**

## Wide Range of Subjects

- **10** faculties with **55** institutes and **237** chairs and **24** clinics
- **Comprehensive university with all subjects** (without engineering)
- **new degree programmes** e. g. Nanostructure Technology, Functional Materials, Games Engineering, Modern China, Digital Humanities, Human-Computer Interaction
- **eight interdisciplinary priority research areas:**
  - Life Sciences
  - Health
  - Molecular Chemistry and Materials
  - Quantum Phenomena in New Materials
  - Digital Society
  - Cultural Heritage
  - Global Change
  - Norms and Behavior

## Quality assurance at the University of Würzburg

Successful German system accreditation (2018)

→ Integrated QA system for teaching and learning

New focus on central administration

- Objective: improving the quality of support services
- Different tasks for quality assurance
  - One-time tasks vs. recurring tasks
- Organisational development as QA model für administration
- New name for unit: quality management and organisational development

## The University of Würzburg Central Administration

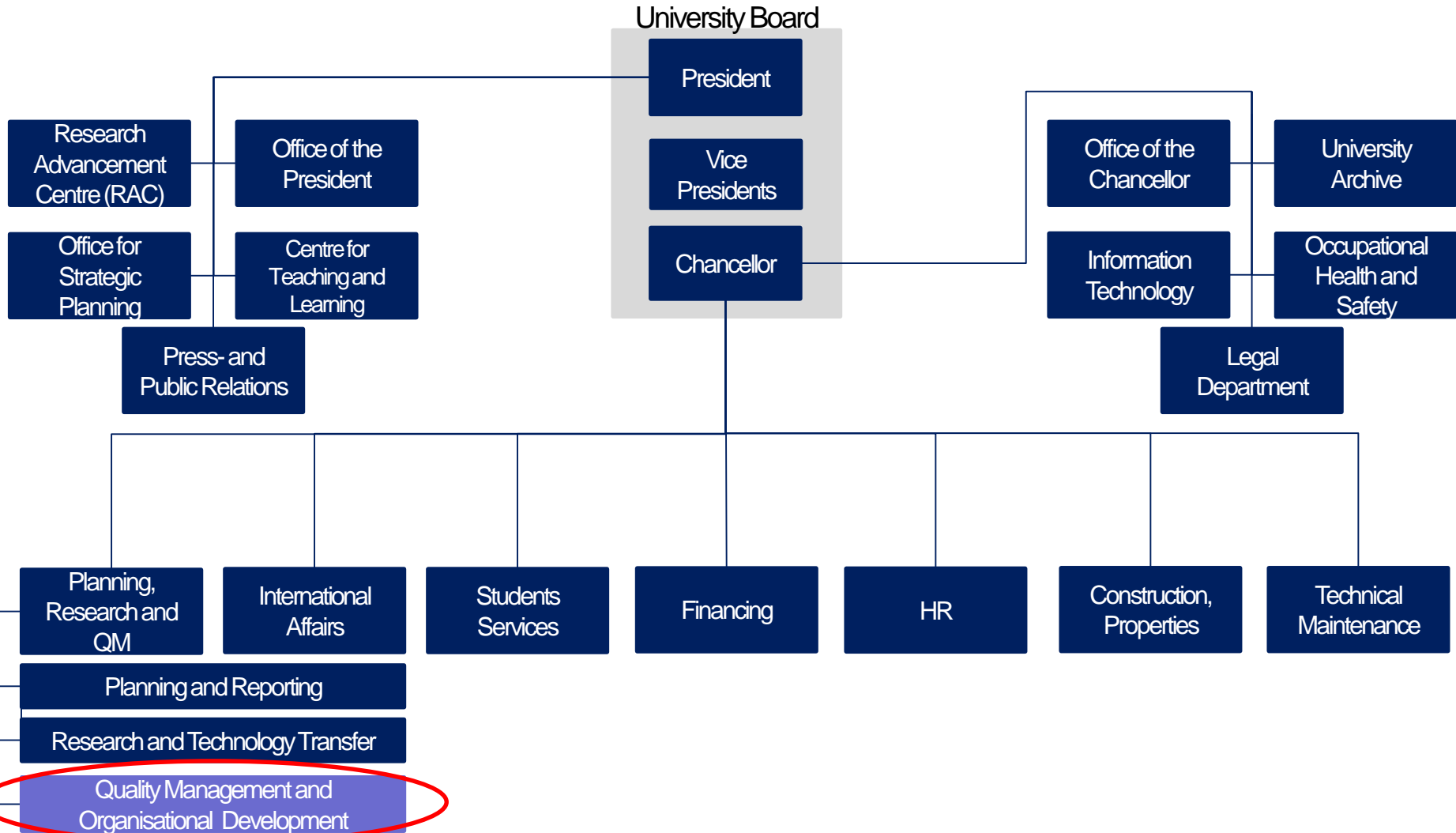
Central Administration as service provider for the university

- 5 presidential staff units

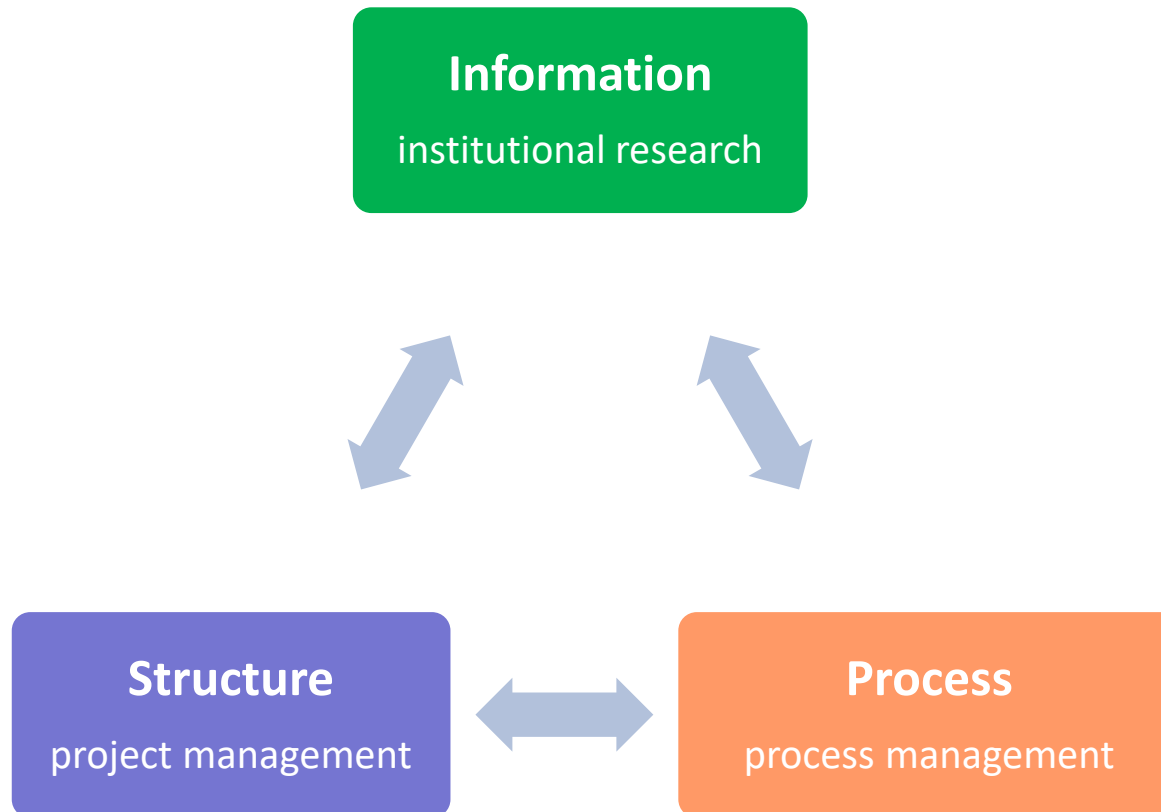
Work is mainly organised in departments

- Little experience in cooperation between departments

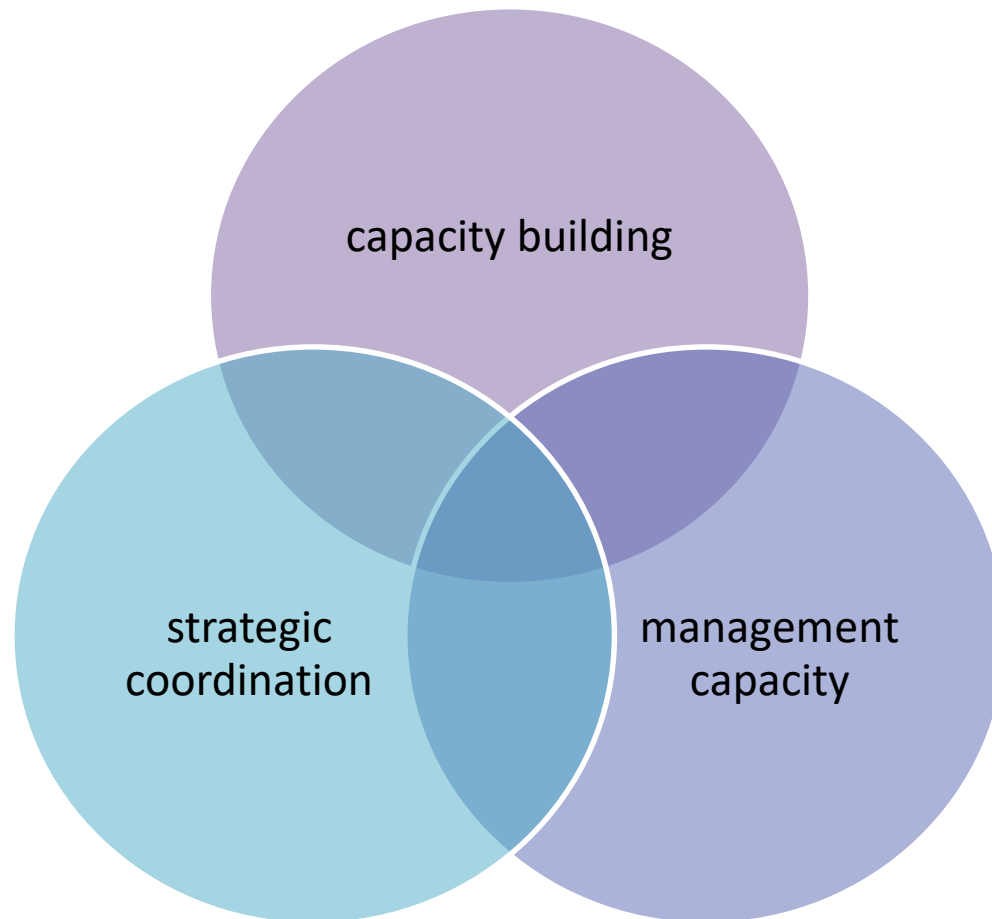

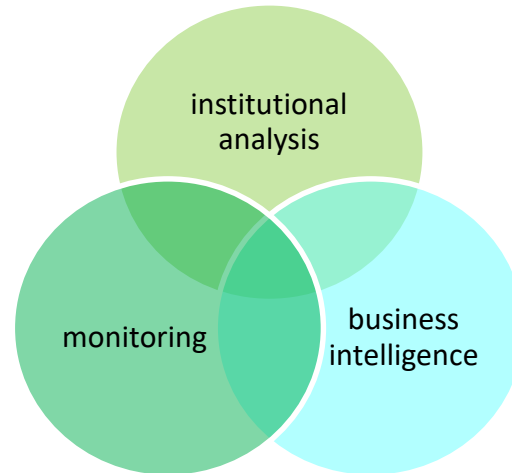
## Campus management system

### Project management



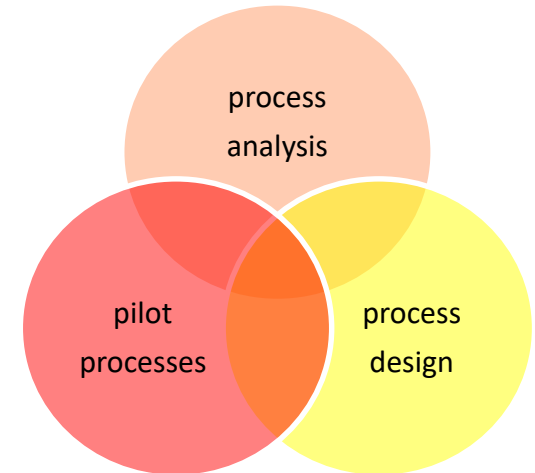
- Project structure

- Provision of information for project decisions

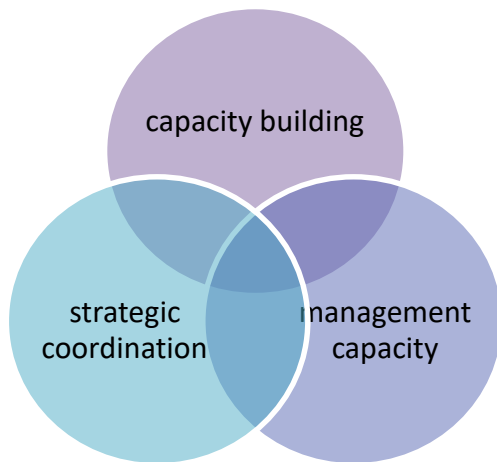
### Process management



- Process analysis and development

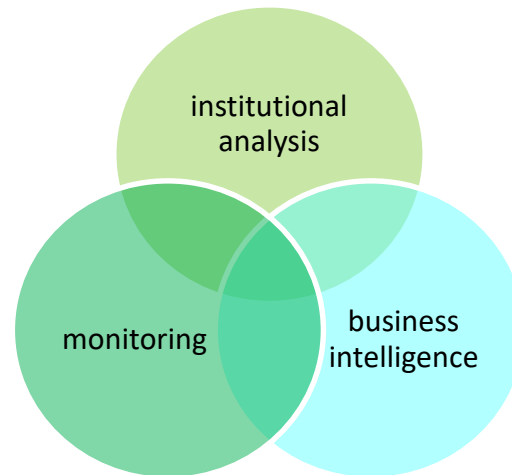
## Company medical services

### Project management



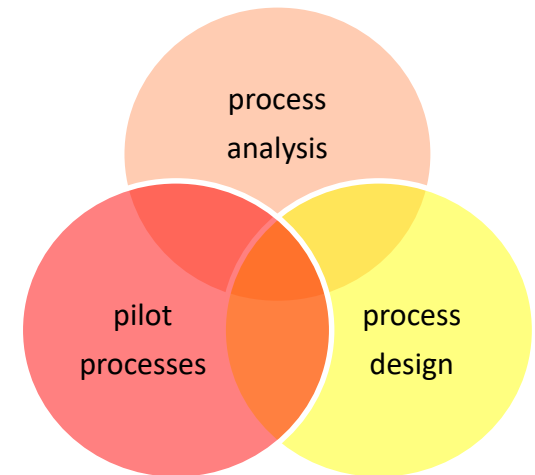
- Creation of an administrative advisory committee

- Provision of information for decision making

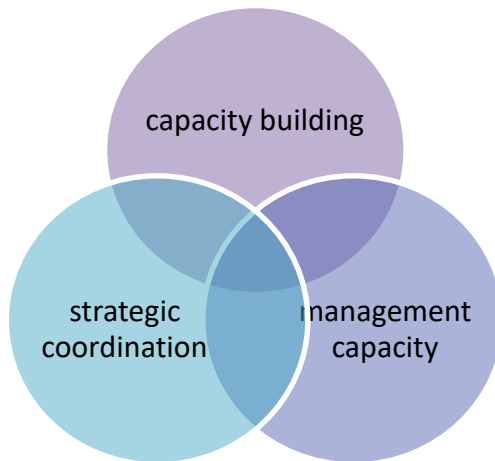

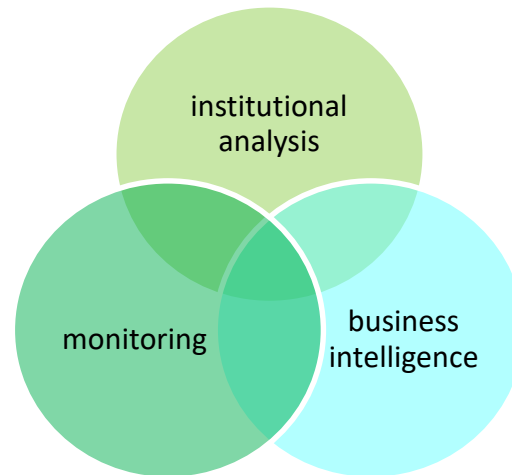

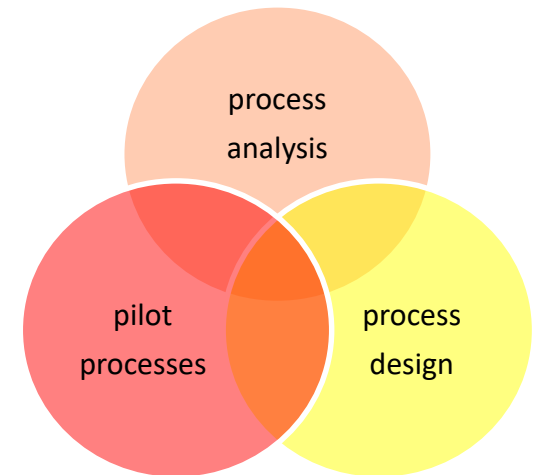
