The role of HEIs

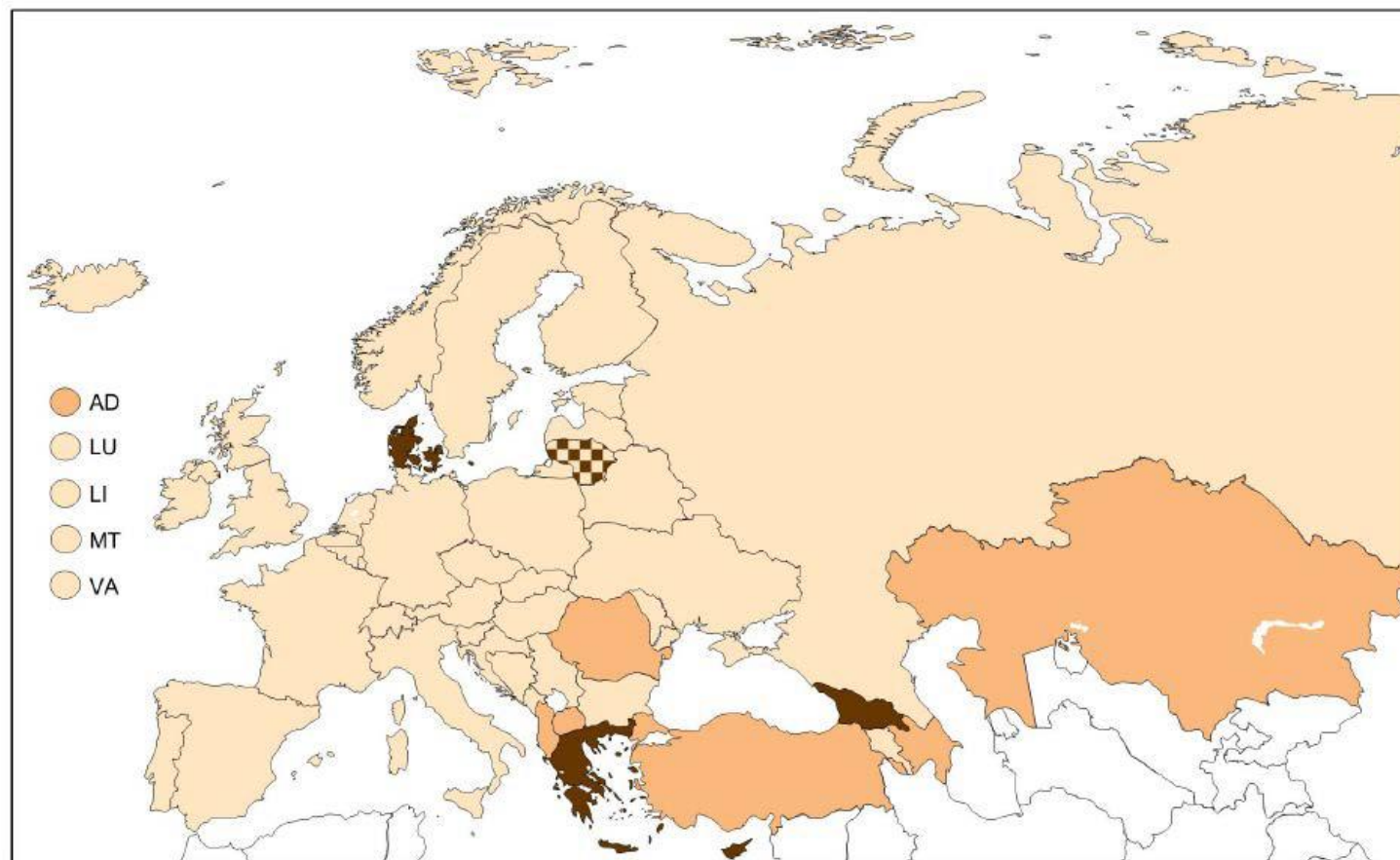


Figure 4.15: Institution which makes final decisions on recognising foreign qualifications for academic purposes, 2016/17, Bologna Implementation Report 2018

Framework for recognition decisions

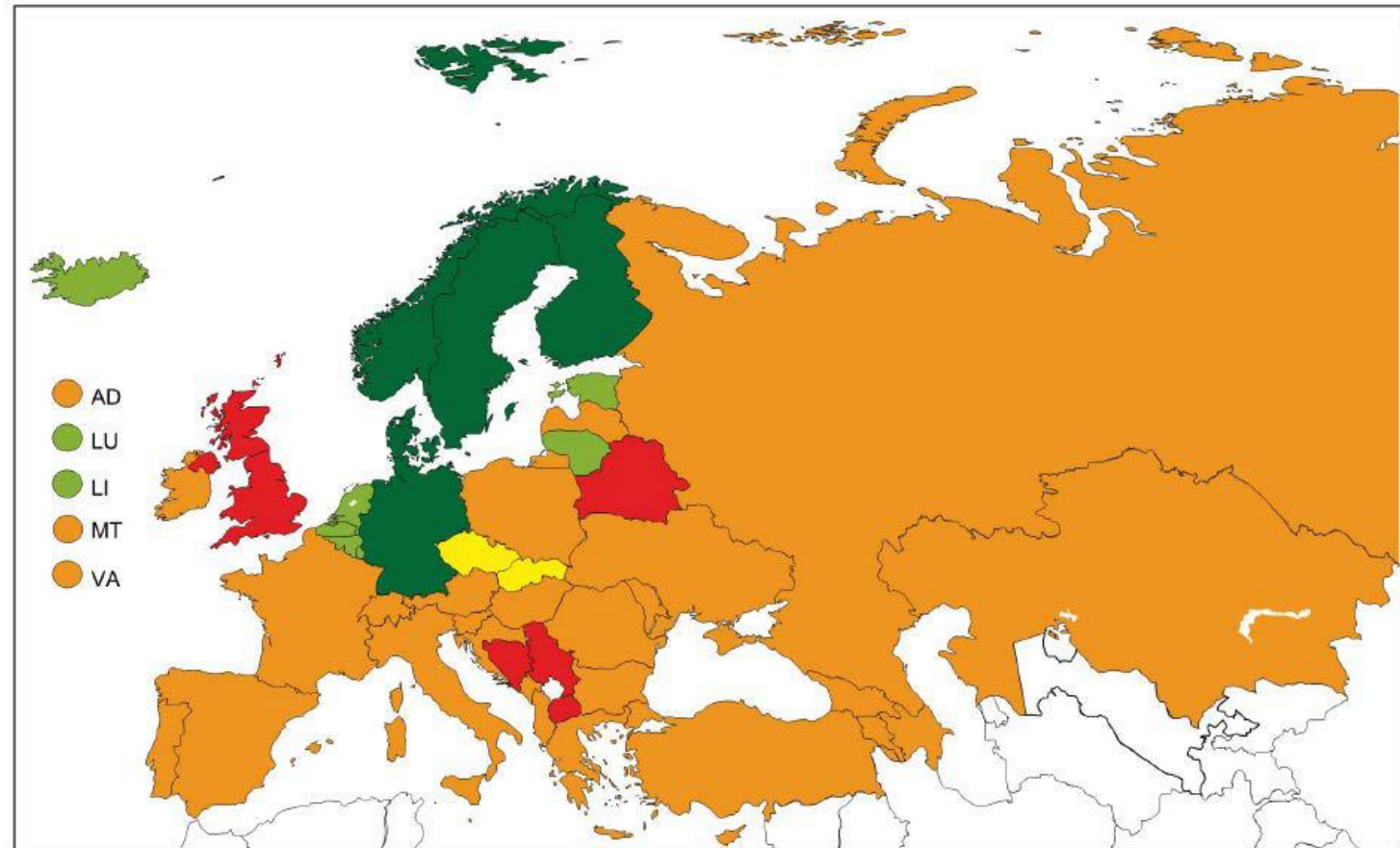
- Lisbon Recognition Convention (LRC) from 1997
 - ✓ recognition in line with the LRC ‘considered one of the key commitments in the Bologna Process’
- European Council Recommendation from November 2018
 - ✓ EU member states committed to automatic recognition
