# Towards greener Erasmus+

- Green horizontal priority to build up knowledge on sustainability and climate action, promote the use of green travel and develop green skills
- European Student Card Initiative and Erasmus+ App to replace paperbased administrative processes with digital processes
- Increased support to promote green travel :
  - 15% increase of standard travel support (all fields)
  - 50 EUR top-up of individual support (for HE students without travel support)
  - 4 days of additional individual support in case of green travel (all fields)
- Monitoring the carbon footprint of mobilities
- Platforms (eTwinning and EPALE) to offer support material and exchange of best practices and policies on environmental sustainability
- Outreach and awareness-raising through various networks (schools, universities, VET providers, youth and sport organisations, NGOs, etc.).

## Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)

- MSCA Green Charter: set of principles which MSCA beneficiaries should follow to minimise the environmental impact of research activities
- Environmental reporting at final report stage
- Compilation of guidance material on best environmental practices
- MSCA portfolio analysis with Green Deal relevance (e.g. biodiversity, zero pollution, clean energy etc.)
- Thematic cluster event (July 2021) bringing together policymakers and projects funded under the MSCA, Erasmus+, EIT etc. in areas related to the Green Deal
- MSCA European Researchers' NIGHT (2021) with a thematic focus on Green Deal priorities
- Researchers at School initiative
