

- Trust, compliance, vaccine uptake etc. require citizen-centric communication



Committed to the truth

Principles of evidence-based expert communication

- Provide the information in an accessible format
- Use clear and shareable content
- Reference trustworthy and and independent sources
- If possible, underline scientific consensus (and that science evolves)
- Create authentic and humble advice and communication
- Build data and evidence into narratives
- More facts won't work need context + translation
- Distinguish policy statements from expert statements
