

In total 929 doctoral students are found from Workday, i.e. 33% of Aalto doctoral students are also employees



AAC

- Academic affairs committee at university level
- Academic affairs committees at six schools

VP education

- Vice president (education) is responsible of doctoral education
- Before 2019, VP (research) was responsible

Doctoral education services

- Part of learning services (about 250 persons for whole Aalto)
- Two persons for university level issues
- 13 persons for school level issues
