Thank you for taking the time to complete this survey. Your feedback about your Erasmus+ experience is extremely important to us.

In this survey, we would like to hear from you what works well in Erasmus+ at your institution, and what does not, whether you think the current programme's objectives are met, whether you have specific issues regarding proposal submission and evaluation, management of grants and financial and strategic aspects.

EUA will publish the findings of this survey and use them as a contribution to the [European Commission \(EC\) interim evaluation of Erasmus+ 2021-27](#). #### **The questionnaire**
