Universities driving sustainability: Outlook on their strategies



Sustainability: a common language for universities?

- Universities want to be key actors: transversal role
- Responsibility is the core driver for their commitment
- Recognition of the importance of sustainability-related topics and growing commitment: 72% of universities have an environmental sustainability strategy
- Focus on environmental aspects
- Goals tend to be broadly articulated in the strategies and more detailed in the action plans.

Sustainability in governance

- Governance models vary between bottom-up and top-down approaches
- 50% have leadership in charge on steering greening measures, 38% have a specific portfolio in the leadership team, 38% have a specific committee
- Student-led initiatives are rising (52% student engagement)
- Frameworks used: UN SDGs (69% of related strategies), national policies (39%), European policies (17%)







From words to action: key themes



- Footprint reduction (energy, waste, mobility) and carbon neutrality commitment
- Interdisciplinarity in research
- Integration of sustainability in education (mandatory courses, study programmes, thesis awards etc.)
- Community engagement (sustainability weeks, days, conferences, workshops etc.)

Less addressed:

- Social sustainability and EDI
- Biodiversity and ecosystem focus
- Circular economy and climate justice





Challenges and targets ahead



- General underfunding and few staff engaged
- Smaller universities lack resources
- Activities on sustainability not always integrated in the strategies

82% of universities have concrete targets. Among the targets:

- Net-zero campuses and low-carbon operations
- Sustainability embedded in all educational programmes
- Green campus labels
