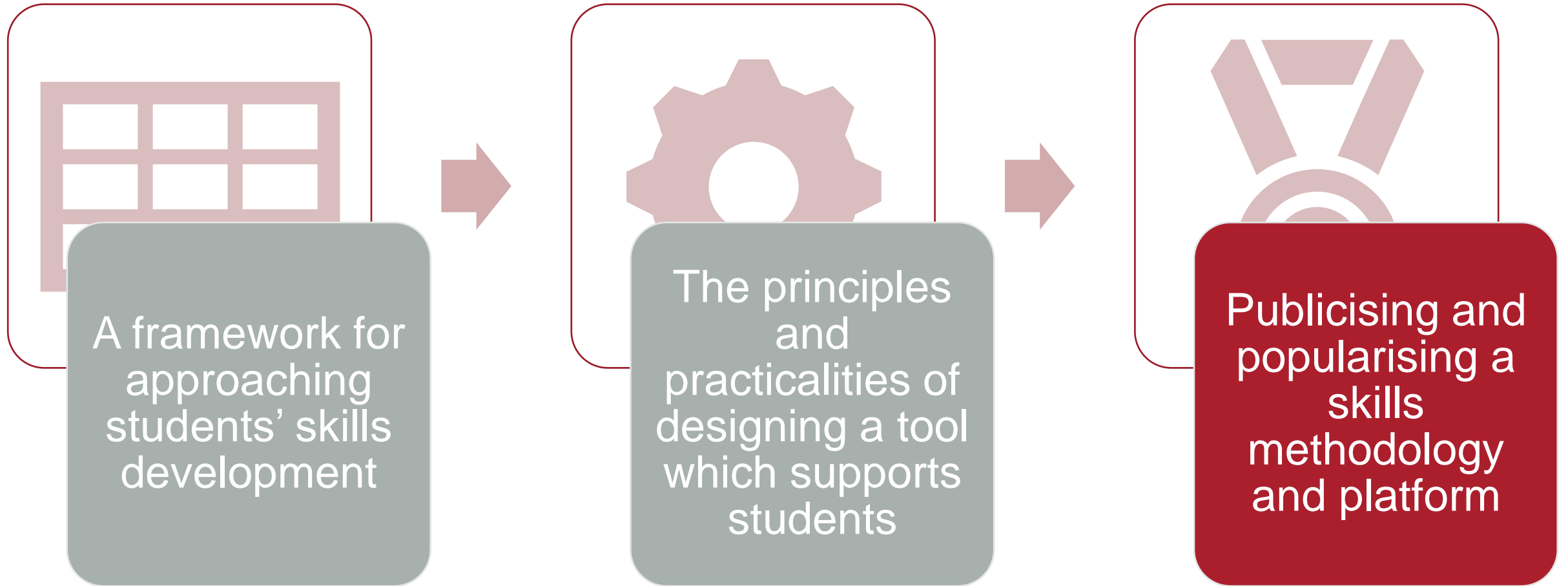
## Volunteering at East Bristol foodbank

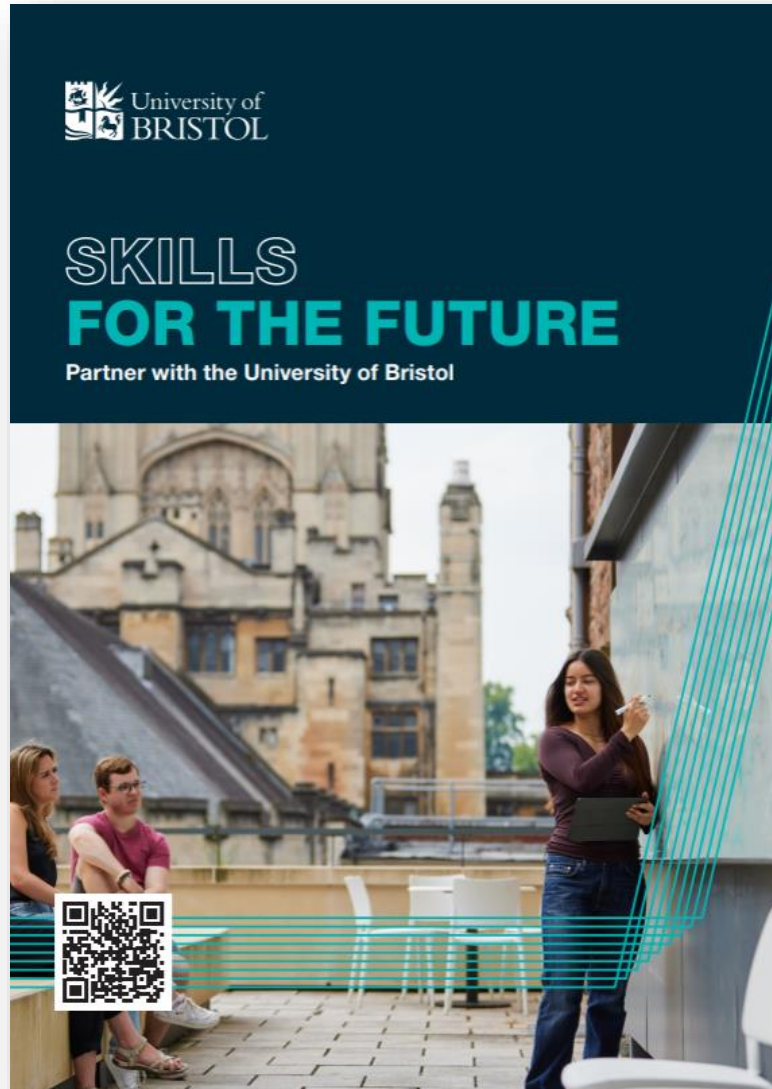

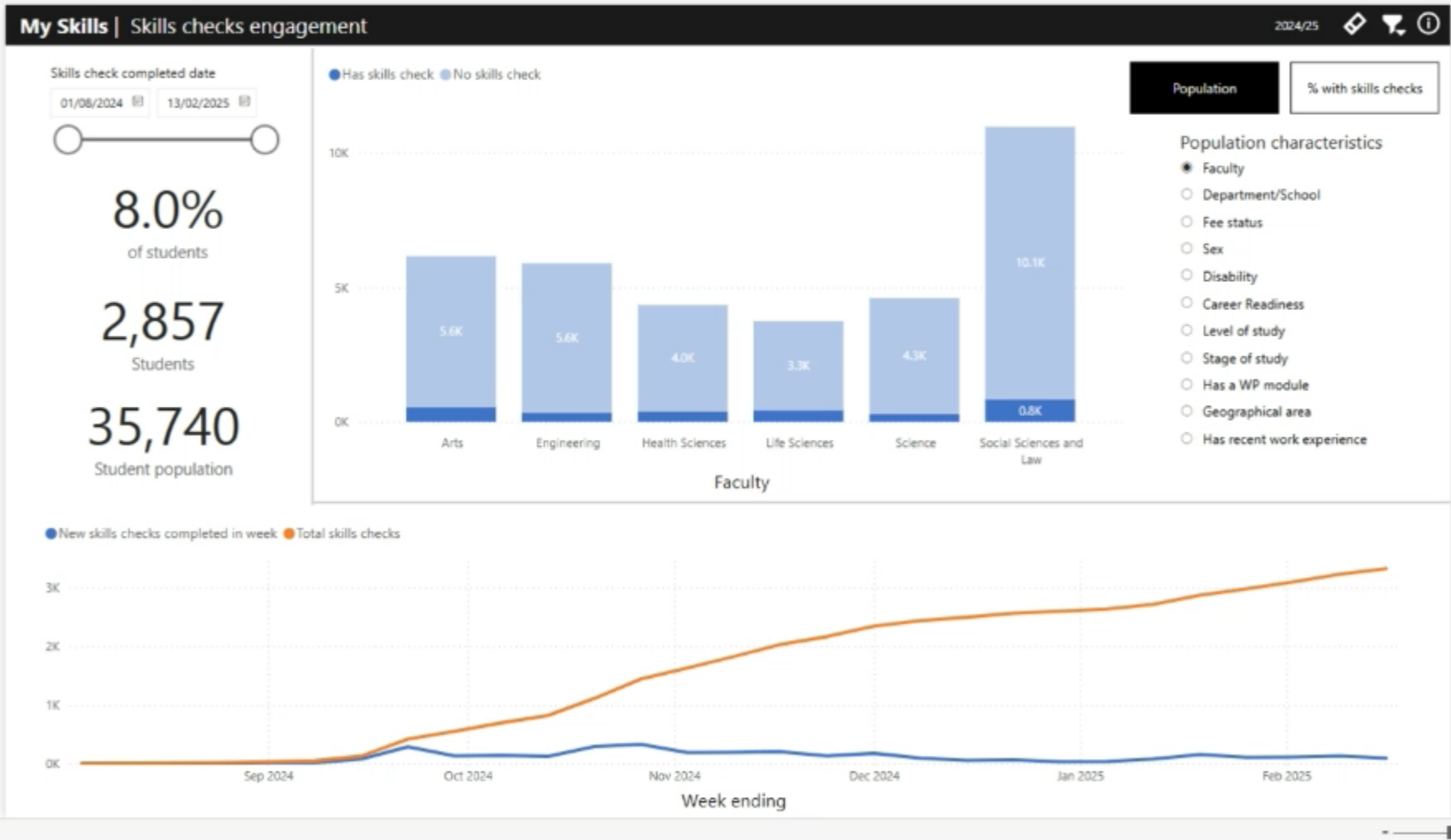

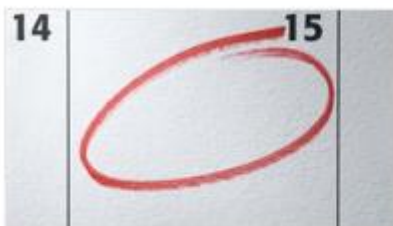
