## ANNEX 1

### Sustainability and greening networks

More than 250 respondents to EUA's survey mentioned specific networks or working groups dedicated to sustainability and greening. Many included a link to the European Universities alliance of which their institution is a member. Some of the networks cited only include 2-3 institutions, or are not specifically dedicated to higher education/have a broader membership.

The remaining 60 regional, national and international networks are listed in this annex. In addition to higher education institutions, they often also involve other actors. Some networks are dedicated to sustainability in general, whereas others focus on fairly specific thematic issues such as green energy, water management practices, etc.
