

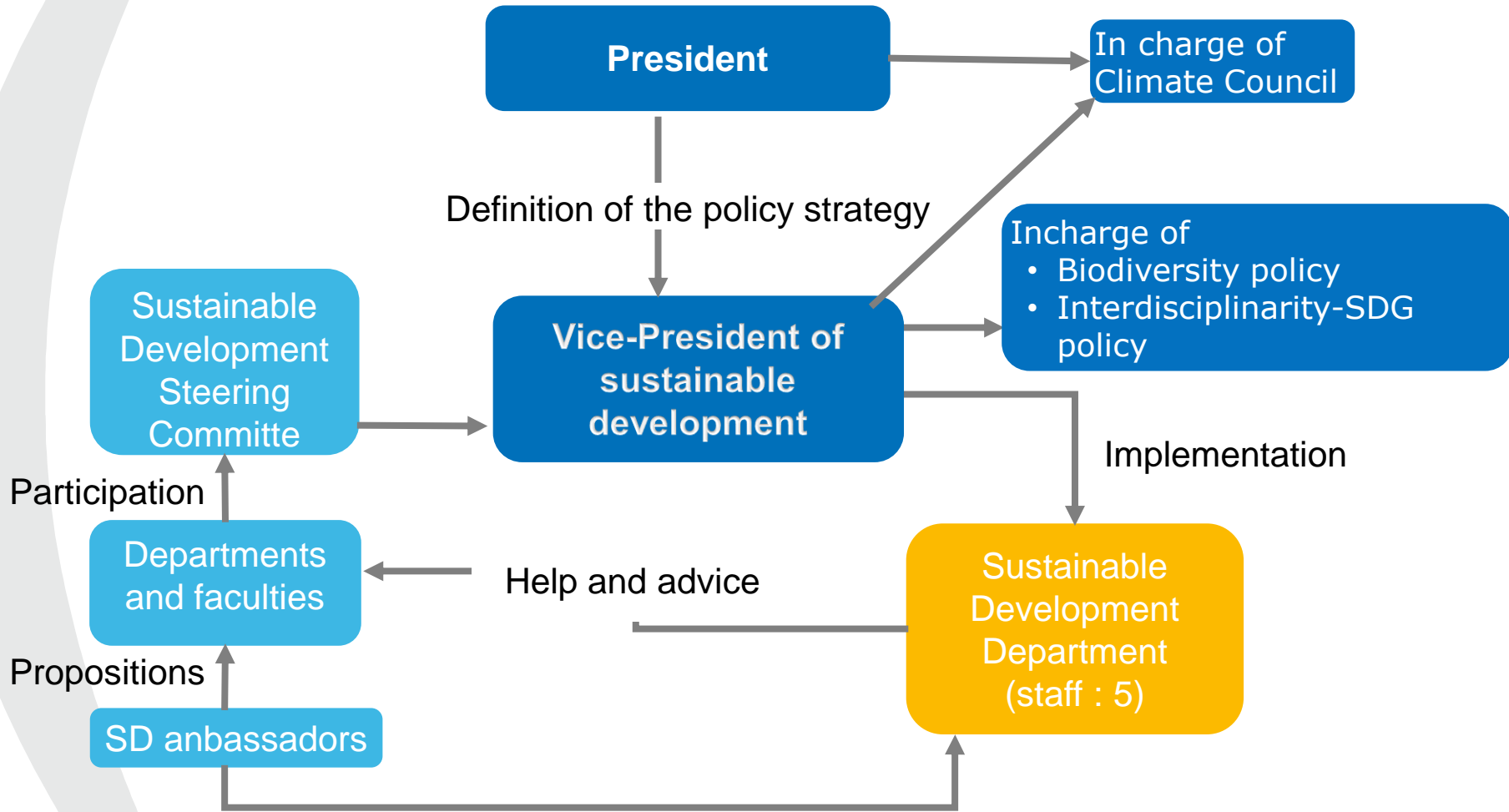

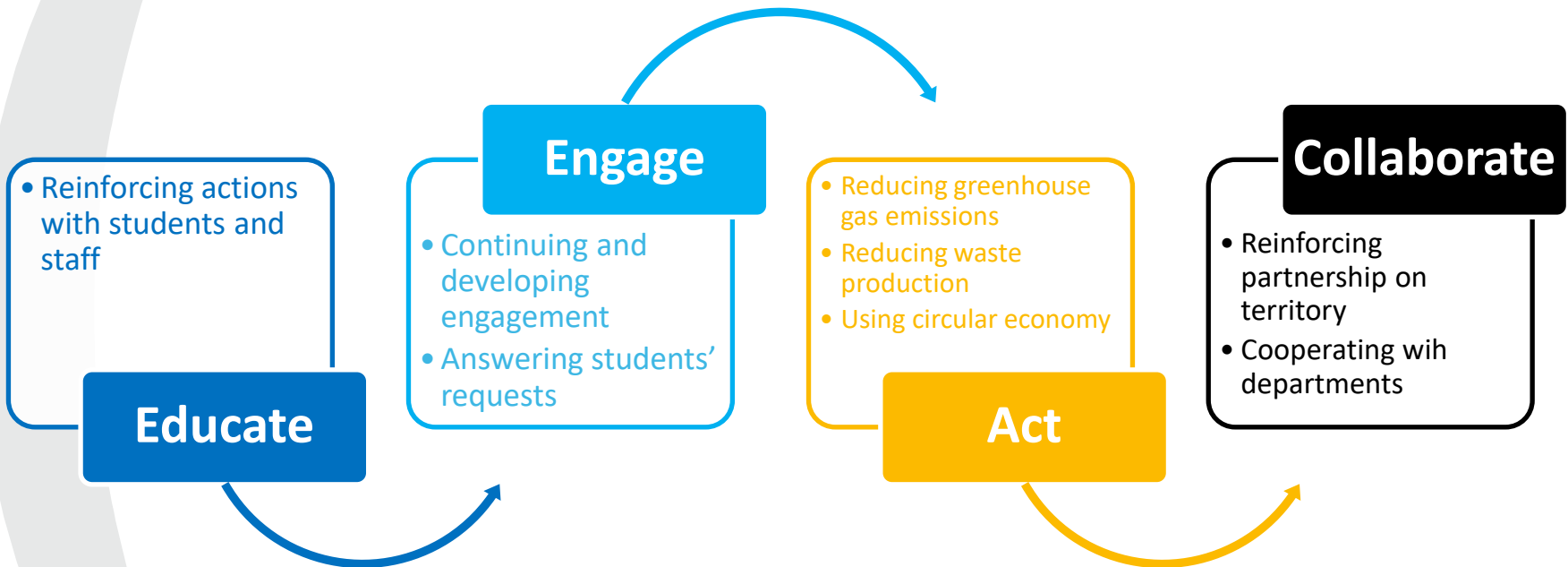

3 Levels

Who ?

- All students

What ?

- Event preparation and organisation
- Participation in a subject proposed by teacher (UICN...)
- Bibliographic report chosen by student

Evaluation
